De-clutter your wardrobe in support of Noah's Ark children's charity

From this week onwards Cardiff residents can start to make valuable donations to the Noah's Ark Children's Hospital Charity using a new scheduled kerbside textile collection scheme. The service will take place alongside alternate 'Black Waste' collections run by Cardiff Council and has been set up in response to the generosity shown by local residents to Noah's Ark. It aims to increase the range of materials collected alongside household recycling and limit the number of clothes simply thrown out in household waste.

Clothes Aid are a social business who have been working with the Noah's Ark appeal since early 2008. To date the partnership has collected almost 3,000 tonnes of unwanted clothing which has generated over £156,000 for the charity. Noah's Ark is the official charity for the Children's Hospital for Wales and raise funds to help the 100,000 vulnerable babies and children in Wales needing specialist medical care each year.

Kerbside collections started in most areas this week and will operate on a 4 weekly cycle to coincide with the 'Black Waste' collections run by Cardiff council. Donna Stevens of Clothes Aid said 'We are extremely grateful for the support the public show for Noah's Ark but we recognise how busy people are. Putting your black bin on the kerbside however, is second nature, and if putting a bag of unwanted clothing next to their bin makes it easier for residents to remember then we're keen to offer this service as a way of thanking residents for their generosity.'
